

TOPIC:

Social Studies

GRADE LEVEL:

3 - 6

TIME:

40 min.

IF I WERE A...

OBJECTIVE:

The student will understand different people and historical

characters.

MATERIALS:

1. Paper and pencil.

PROCEDURE:

- Lead the class in a discussion about a historical character (Roman, Egyptian, pilgrim, Viking, WWI soldier, etc.) with whom they are familiar and knowledgeable.
- 2. Have the class forecast first person answers to the following questions about a selected character:
 - a. Where do you live? Describe your home.
 - b. What do you eat?
 - c. Where does your drinking water come from?
 - d. Describe your feelings about the historical event.
 - e. Tell your part in the event.
- Have each student choose a character to write about, answering the above questions.
- 4. Allow time for the students to share their papers to see how similar they are.
- 5. Discuss the likenesses and differences.
- 6. Allow the students to keep their work.
