## NEWSPAPER NURSERY RHYME

**OBJECTIVE:** The student will understand newspaper articles by writing nursery rhyme news.

### MATERIALS NEEDED:

1. Paper and pencil.
2. Nursery rhymes.
3. Chalkboard or chart paper.



### PROCEDURE:

1. Discuss with the students the nursery rhymes they can think of. Write the titles on the board or chart paper.
2. Read the titles and have the class repeat them together.
3. As a class, decide which nursery rhyme would make the most interesting news story.
4. Have the class give their ideas for the news story.
5. Write the ideas on the board to see if they answer the questions of a good news story (who, when, what, how or why).
6. Assign the class, as individuals or partners, to create their own news story. Remind them to answer the questions who, when, where, what, how or why.
7. Put the written articles in a booklet to be displayed for the class to read.
