PRETENDING

OBJECTIVE: The student will create and describe a picture.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

1. Manila art paper.
2. Crayons.

PROCEDURE:

1. Tell the students they are going to create a picture and tell about it.
2. Tell the students they are to select one color, choose any that they have in their box, and pretend to be that color.
3. Have them close their eyes and answer these questions in their minds as they think about their color:
 - a. What do you look like?
 - b. How do you move?
 - c. What kind of noise do you make?
 - d. How are you useful?
 - e. What is your name?
4. Tell the students to open their eyes and remember what they envisioned.
5. Pass out paper and crayons (if needed).
6. Give the students time to recreate their "mind" pictures on the art paper.
7. Give the students time to tell you and the class about their picture.
