



TOPIC: Adaptable
GRADE LEVEL: 3 - 12
TIME: Adaptable

WHAT IF?

OBJECTIVE: The student will analyze and evaluate possible conflicts and problems that might occur if forecasted situations were to happen.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

1. One copy of the Student Activity Sheet for each class member -
OPTIONAL.
2. Chalkboard.
3. Paper and pencil for each student.

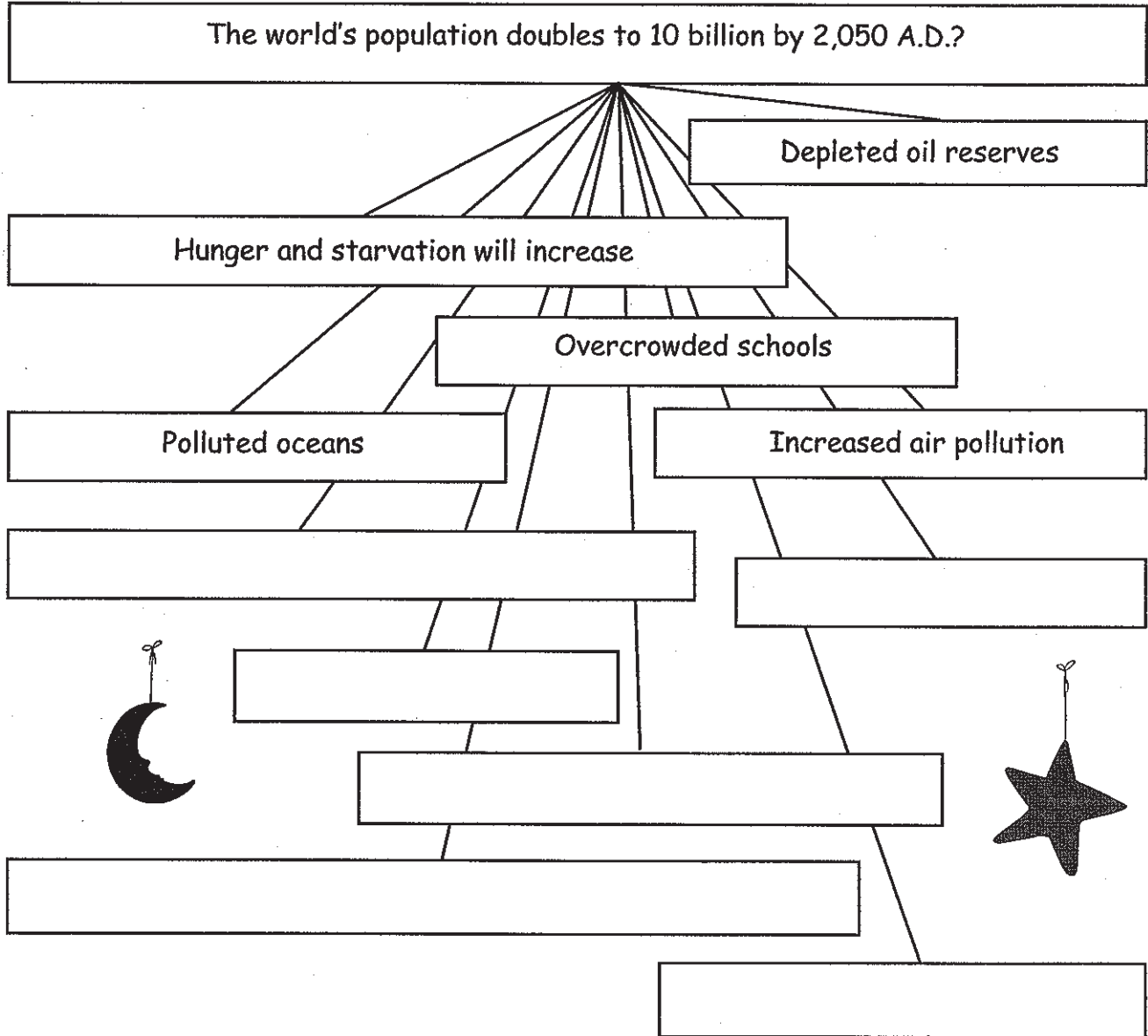


PROCEDURE:

1. Discuss with the students the meaning of conflicts and problems as it related to this activity.
2. Work through the activity sheet orally with the students asking for several forecasted responses. If chalkboard is being used, record the responses.
3. Instruct students to create their own "What if" situations based on events that pertain to the subject that the class is studying , i.e., foreign language: What if an international language were developed? Math: What if people do not learn to solve mathematical problems and rely totally on computers and/or calculators? Science: What if medical research is unable to discover a cure for cancer? etc.
4. Have students volunteer to share their situations and lead a class discussion asking for forecasted responses from other class members.
5. Continue the activity as long as student interest exists and time allows.
