

TOPIC: Foreign Language  
GRADE LEVEL: Secondary  
TIME: One Class Period

## FOREIGN LANGUAGE WORD PUZZLES

**OBJECTIVE:** The student will review a particular language vocabulary by completing crossword puzzles and/or word search and by designing an original word puzzle with a key.

### MATERIALS NEEDED:

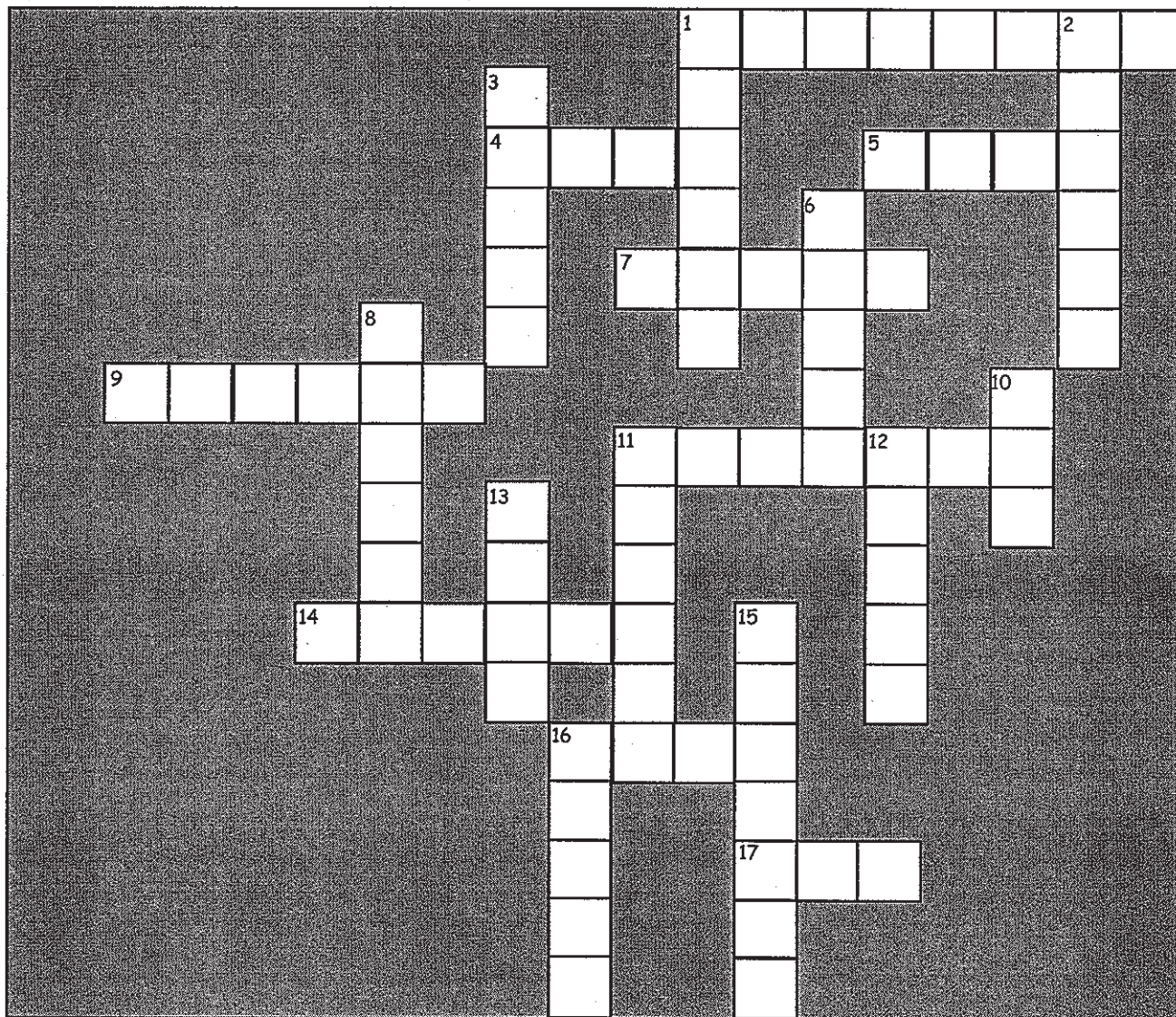
1. One copy of each word puzzle Student Activity Sheet to be used for each student.
2. Textbooks, when available, to be used as student reference.
3. Teacher's Key.
4. Two pieces of graph paper for each student for Procedure B.

### PROCEDURE A

1. Distribute Activity Sheets to students.
2. Assign students to complete the provided word puzzles.
3. Check word puzzles in class or have them handed in at the end of the period for teacher correction.

### PROCEDURE B

1. Discuss how a crossword puzzle is designed.
2. Assign students to select a specific number of vocabulary words from the language being studied and develop the clues that will be used for their original crossword puzzle.
3. The students will then design the pattern for the puzzle on a piece of graph paper. Each puzzle is to include the across clues and a correcting key.
4. Collect the puzzles and leave for the regular classroom teacher to grade and/or give extra credit.



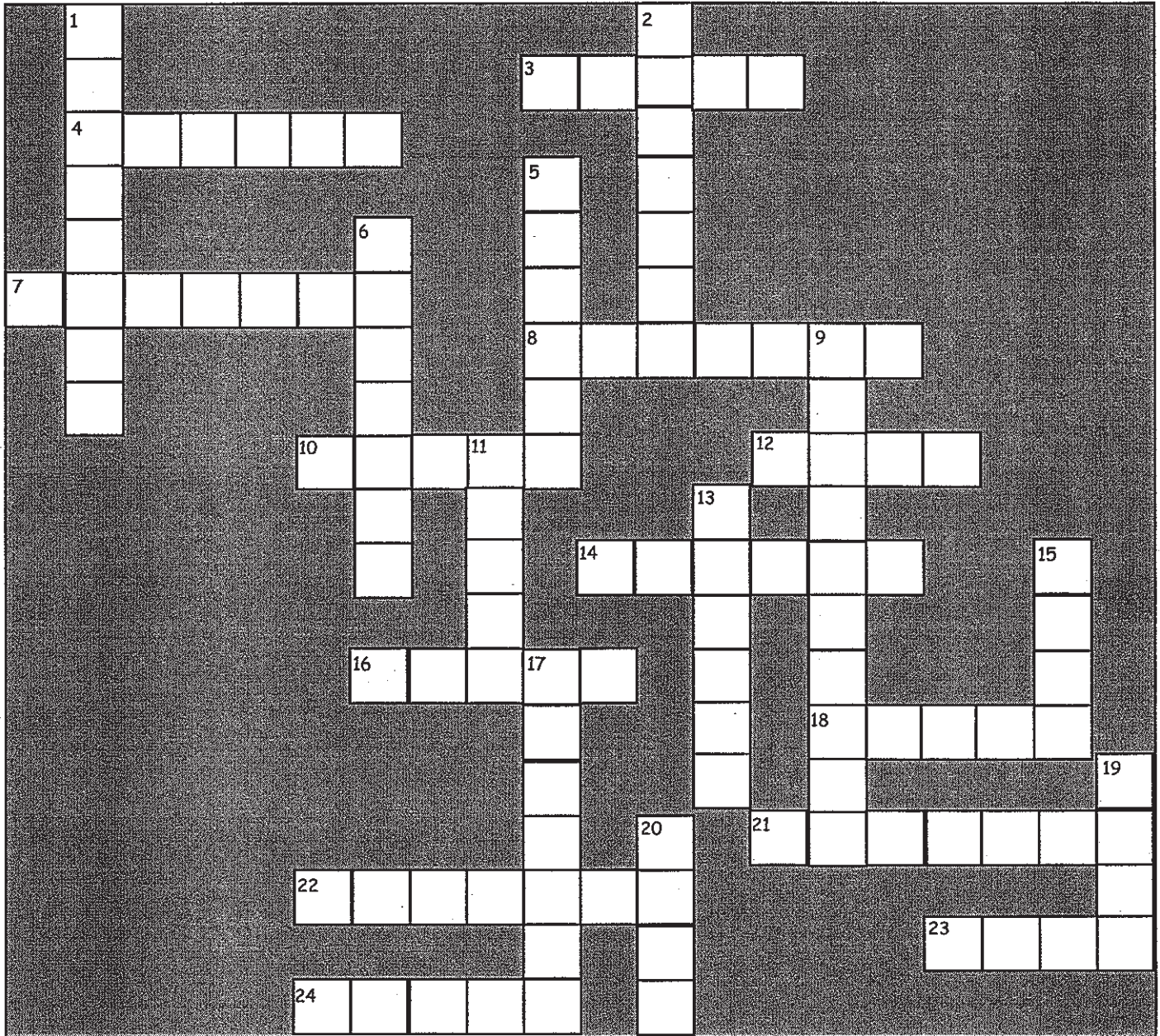

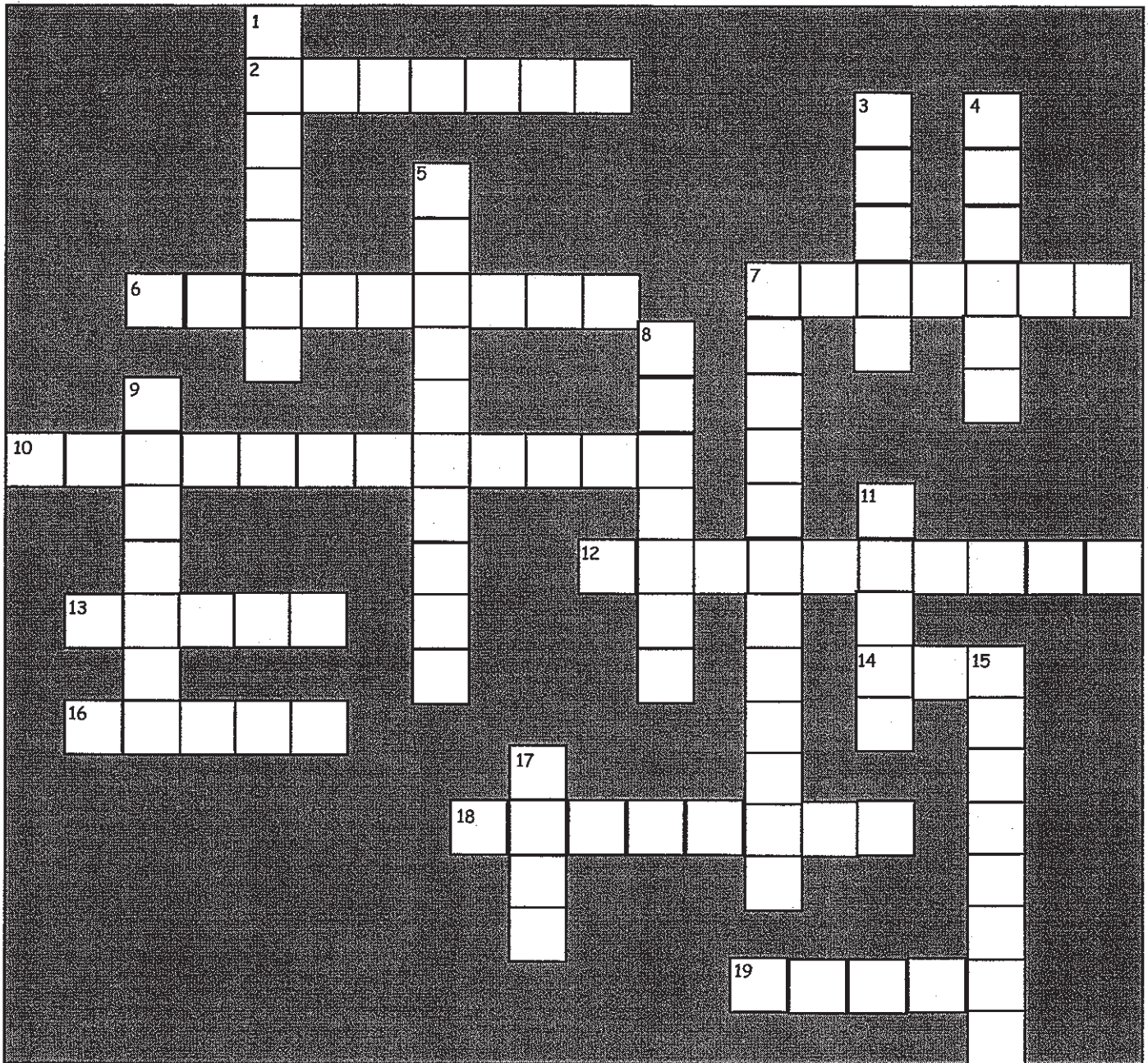

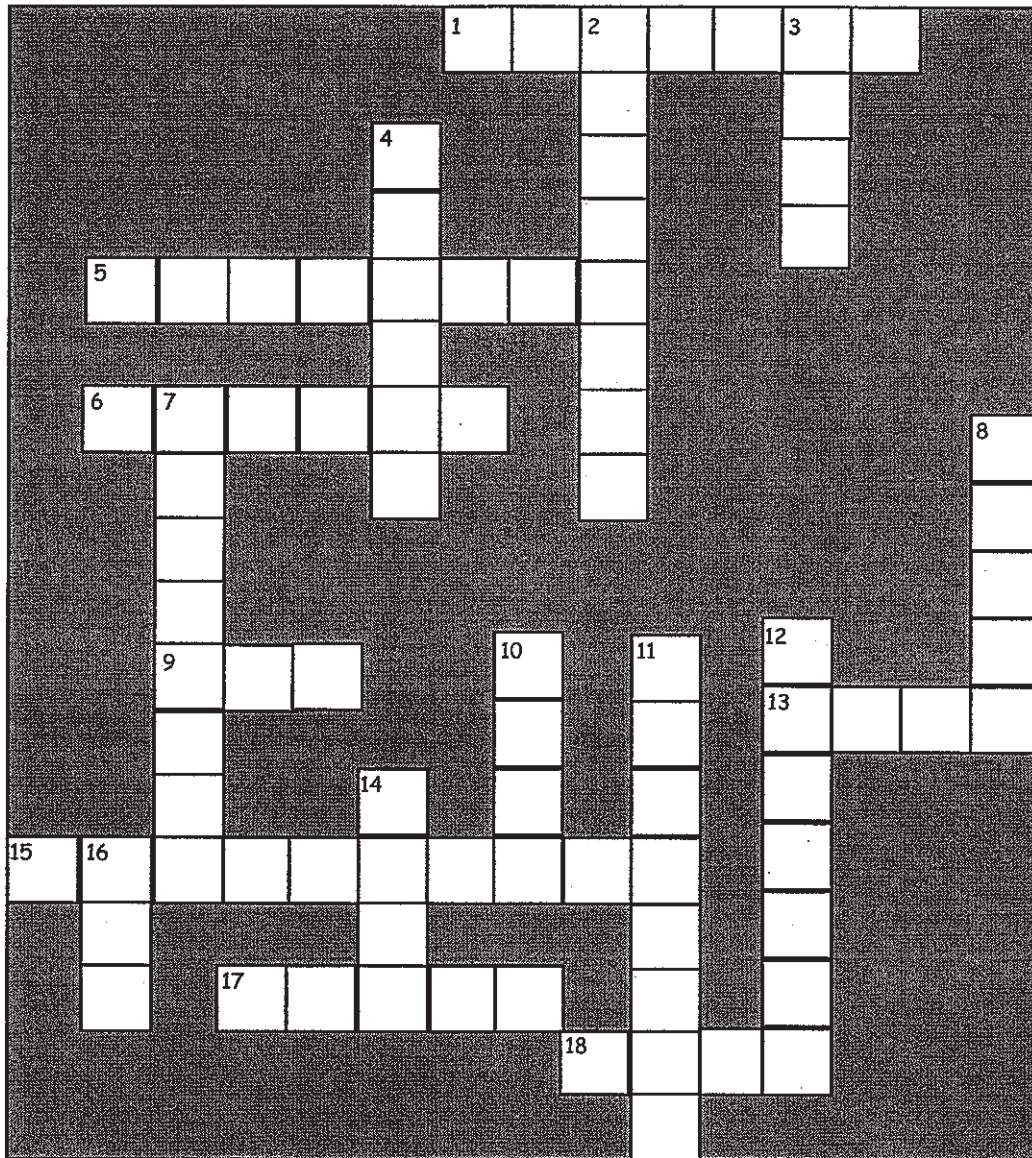
