



TOPIC: Social Studies

GRADE LEVEL: Secondary
TIME: One Class Period

SOCIAL STUDIES/WORLD HISTORY CROSSWORD PUZZLE

OBJECTIVE: The student will learn and/or review facts from history by completing a crossword puzzle.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

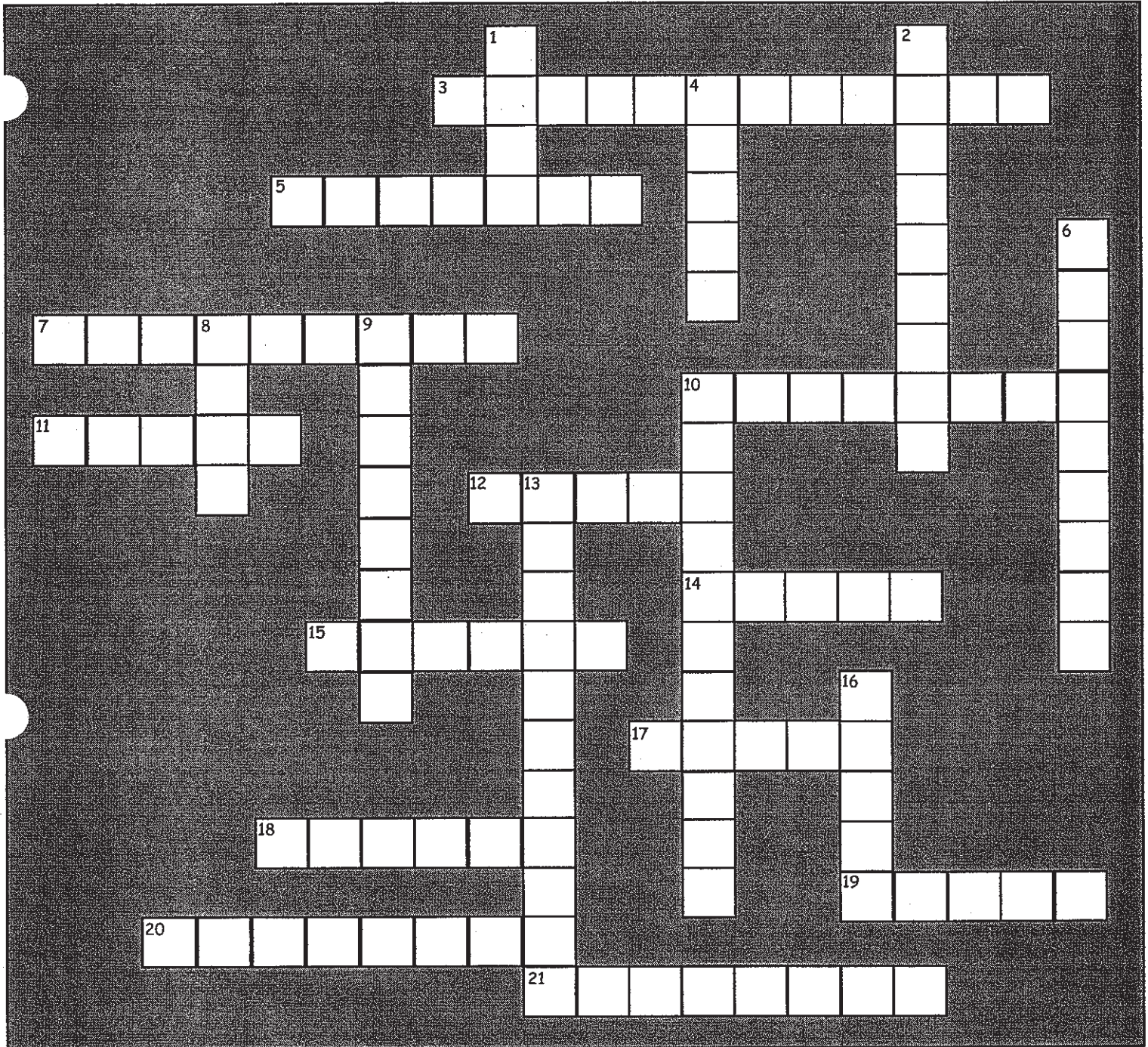
1. One copy of word puzzle Student Activity Sheet to be used for each student.
2. Textbooks, when available, to be used as student reference.
3. Teacher's Key.
4. Two pieces of graph paper for each student for Procedure B.

PROCEDURE A:

1. Distribute Activity Sheet to students.
2. Assign students to complete the provided word puzzle.
3. Check word puzzles in class or have handed in at the end of the period for teacher correction.

PROCEDURE B:

1. Discuss how a crossword puzzle is designed.
2. Assign students to select a specific number of vocabulary words from the Social Studies or World History subject being studied and develop the clues that will be used for their original crossword puzzle.
3. The students will then design the pattern for the puzzle on a piece of graph paper. Each puzzle is to include the across clues and a correcting key.
4. Collect the puzzles and leave for the regular classroom teacher to grade and or give extra credit.
